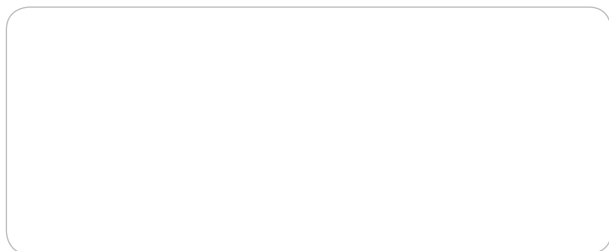

Guidelines for Grant Applications by individuals

The Royal London Society (RLS) provides grants toward rehabilitation of offenders by encouraging and supporting vocational training and resettlement education, which leads directly to or is supportive of employment opportunities.

Currently RLS will consider applications from individual serving prisoners, those recently released or those on probation living or intending to live in the Greater London and South East area (independent confirmation of an address is required).

RLS **does not** consider grant applications in respect of the following:-

- Accommodation costs including rents, lease, licence or deposits.
- Household items, furniture or domestic appliances.
- Debts or loans of any kind including students loans.
- Computer equipment including laptops and associated equipment.
- Driving lessons, theory or practical tests if for domestic purposes.
- Open University/Distance learning courses not related to employment.
- Personal Clothing not related to employment.

RLS **does not normally** consider

- Hobby and Recreational Grants for serving prisoners except when the applicant has 12 months still to serve).

References

- RLS requires written references and/or recommendations in support of each application. Applications not supported by written references will not be considered.
- References for those currently in prison should preferably be from Prison Staff (Personal Officer, Group or Wing Officer, Senior or Principal Officer).
- Applications from those recently released or on probation/supervision should be supported by written references from Probation Officers or Supervisors. Written references from other parties will be considered i.e. Housing Trusts, Social Services and supportive agencies working in the community.

It will help your application if you:

1. Show you are seeking funds from others who are prepared to share the cost such as other charities
2. Show that you are making a personal contribution to the total cost where possible.

Please note that Royal London Society has limited funds and not all applications will be approved. However we wish you well and look forward to receiving your application in due course.
